


FUELING THE GENERATOR OF JOBS

- Approximately 50% new jobs from startups
- Remaining new jobs come from "small business"
- Big business job creation is zero because they tend to acquire competitors, cut staff, reduce workforce or move companies outside the country
- Economic Ecosystem is 100% dependent on startups and small business to create and sustain job creation
- For the first time in 35 years, American business deaths outnumber business births.
- 400,000 new businesses are being born annually nationwide, while
 470,000 per year are dying.




LEVELS OF ENTREPRENEURIAL TALENT

CREATING AN ENTREPRENEURIAL ECOSYSTEM

- Identify Talent: Highly talented students are three times more likely to start a business
- **Foster the Talent:** Students who have access to training and education about starting a business are twice as likely to plan to start a business
- Create the right environment: If your country is business-friendly, it doubles the odds of someone starting a business
- **Nurturing Partnership:** Students who have a likely business partner are three times more likely to start a business
